As we end 2023 I want to SHOUT THANK YOU to everyone who has carried us in prayer, donated, volunteered, or been a part of supporting Inspire in any way. You have truly helped make 2023 a phenomenal year for us as we have carried out our mission to "inspire artists to grow in community and share the gospel through creative works." This year, we really focused on three major things: First, our team has worked hard to make a strong financial foundation for Inspire. Second, we began building a stronger staff and volunteer team to support events and initiatives. Third, God opened doors for us to make multiple new community connections. I am so excited to say that this year, Inspire partnered with 5 churches in our region. We also held events at 5 different locations this year and hope to partner with more churches, businesses and nonprofits in 2024. This is a big deal and an answer to many prayers in 2022. We have been working hard behind the scenes to build new connections in our community and are so excited to see what becomes of those in 2024. I am so proud of our team at Inspire and how hard they have worked to make the various events and initiatives possible. Here are some key stats, celebrations and God moments from 2023.


Inspire 2023

- Inspire Worship Co. held 17 songwriting sessions
- Inspire Worship Co. completed and released our second full length album "Peacemaker," selling 50+ albums for an income over \$1000 (June-Nov)
- Approximately 1,250 streams of "Peacemaker" songs across platforms (June-Nov)



- Inspire Worship Co performed 6 free community concerts this year including Renew Worship at the Crossing Church, the Kernersville Spring Folly, Peacemaker Album Release Concert, WBFJ Local Flavors, Tabitha Ministries Benefit Event, and lastly, Christmas for the City 2023.
- Inspire Worship Co. performed 2 free mini live stream sessions on Facebook Live
- Inspire Worship Co. was featured on the radio! We were interviewed by Kurt Meyers about our new album on WBFJ Local Flavors
- Inspire Worship Co. partnered with Given Coffee to host our first Open Mic Night with 8 local songwriters and about 70 people in attendance





- We held 6 Art Co Classes and 3 Artist Meet-ups
- 70 people attended Inspire Art Co Classes in 2023
- Our Poiema Art Showcase saw a 50% increase in artists, and double the attendance of the prior year!
- Inspire Art Co. had our first ever interactive art booth at Christmas for the City!
- We had one craft booth at the Kernersville Spring Folly and also set up our original art at many events throughout the year.





God moments in 2023:

• The process of preparing our Inspire Worship Co. musicians to record in the studio, as well as the recording process itself, was a huge amount of work personally and collectively for Inspire Worship Co. members. Our "Peacemaker" album release concert was a powerful testimony of worship to the community and the church where we played. Hearing the stories of those who have been touched through these songs has been affirmational to the team who poured out sacrificially to write and record them.

Financial Milestones

- Inspire held 5 bake sales at 3 locations, bringing in over \$2000
- Inspire held a Yard Sale bringing in over \$2500
- We had 3 businesses sponsor our Poiema Showcase this year with over \$1500!
- On Giving Tuesday, we brought in \$700!
- We met many of our financial goals for 2023 and were able to consistently compensate our existing staff
 - Non Churched people from a local coffee shop attended our Poeima Showcase event and had a positive experience with the church.
 - After much, MUCH prayer, God brought us our new Art Co Director, Melissa Edwards!
 - We heard beautiful testimonies and songs from 8 local songwriters, including 3 new-to-Inspire groups, at our Open Mic night at Given Coffee. The stories and songs shared were an incredibly meaningful way of sharing the gospel!
 - We were able to touch the lives of 8,000+ people in the Winston Salem Community at Christmas for the City
